

Aquilegia Swan

Plant type:	Hardy perennial. First year flowering.
Uses:	Pot plant, container or bedding plant
Plant height:	46 - 60cm
Sowing:	Sow mid-September to late October for late March to mid-May sales. Sow February - May for July - November sales. 21 - 24°C. Cover with a thin layer of Vermiculite. Light is required. Germination in 1- 2 weeks.

Approximate crop timing (mid season)

Sowing to transplanting	6 - 8 weeks
Sowing to flowering	22 - 28 weeks
	Available as a Ball 40, Ball 84, Ball 230 plug

Growing on:

Temperature	Grow seedlings/ plugs at 18 - 20 °C Grow on at 16°C - 20°C day, 13 - 18°C night to bulk up vegetative growth. Vernalisation is required, but temperature can go as high at 13°C at night and 15°C during the day. The duration of treatment is 4 weeks at 5°C, or 6 weeks at 13°C. Start cool treatment after 12 - 15 leaf stage. 4 - 6 weeks to finish crop.
pH	5.8 - 6.2
Feeding	Feed regularly with 200 ppm N at an EC of 1.0
Growth regulation	Not usually required. If necessary the plant will respond to Daminozide.
Pot size	14 - 16cm pots
Planting out spacing	30 - 40cm
Common diseases	Powdery Mildew and Botrytis
Common pests	Spider Mites and Aphids
