| Plant type: | Tender annual |
| Plant height: | 15 – 20cm |
| Sowing: | Sow mid-February to March. 15°C. Cover with a thin layer of fine Vermiculite. Germination 1 – 2 weeks. |

Approximate crop timing (mid season)

| Sowing to flowering | 11 – 13 weeks |
| Ball 350 to flowering | 8 weeks |

Growing on:

| Temperature | 16 – 18°C |
| pH | 6.5 |
| Feeding | Very low feeding requirement; high fertilisation results in heavy leaves. |
| Pack/Pot size | Packs, 9 – 10.5cm pot |
| Growth regulation | Not generally required but can use if conditions are too warm. |
| Planting out spacing | 10cm |
| Advice | Grow cool and keep the plants on the dry side to encourage bud formation. |
| Common pests | Aphids |
