## **Cleome Odyssee**

Plant type: Tender perennial
Uses: Garden and patio plant

Plant height: 80-100cm

**Sowing:** Sow January to April for May to July flowering, alternating 30°C day

and 20°C night. Light is required for germination.

## Approximate crop timing (mid season)

Sowing to flowering 13-16 weeks Sowing to transplanting 3-4 weeks Transplanting to flowering 10-12 weeks

**Growing on:** 

Temperature 18-20°C day and 16-18°C night.

High temperatures combined with low light will promote stretching.

pH 5.6- 6.0. Cleome can tolerate lower pH levels than most other bedding

crops.

Compost Use compost that drains well. EC 1.8-2.5.

Feeding Cleome is a heavy feeder. Constant liquid feed at 300 ppm with 20-10-

20. Irrigate with clear water after every third feeding.

Growth regulation Plants will respond to Bonzi and Daminozide.

Daminozide however does delay flowering by about one week.

Pack/Pot size 1.5 to 2 litre pots. In pots smaller than 1.5 litre, expect to sell Cleome

as a small green plant.

Advice Maintain moderate moisture levels. Media should be moist to the touch,

but not saturated. Do not let plants wilt. Transplant plugs well before

they become root bound.

Common diseases Pythium, Powdery Mildew

Common pests Sciarid Flies
