Growth regulation Once the basal growth develops after transplanting pinch plants back to

get compact plants with bushy habit. Even mature plants quickly

recover after cutting back if growth becomes straggly. We have not found chemical growth regulation effective.

Pack/Pot size 1 plant per 9 cm pot or 3 plants per 12 cm pot.

Planting out spacing 20 x 20 cm.

25 plants per m sq.

Advice The root system is very fine and needs careful handling at the

transplanting stage.

Water in well after transplanting then dry down for growing on.

Plants require good light levels.

Common diseases Root diseases e.g. Pythium and Phytophthora.
