Culture Information

Matthiola (Stock) Cinderella

Plant type: Tender annual - selectable Stock.

Uses: Bedding or pot plant

Plant height: 25 - 35cm

Sowing: December - February.

15 - 20°C. Cover with an average layer of medium Vermiculite.

Germination 1 - 2 weeks.

Approximate crop timing (mid season)

Sowing to transplanting 2-3 weeks Sowing to flowering 13-15 weeks

February sowing naturally flowers at the end of April/May. December sowing with supplementary 14 hour light through mid-January and February will flower at the end of March/April.

Growing on:

Temperature 5 - 8°C after seedlings establish but before transplanting to allow leaf

colour differentiation for selection. Only pale yellow/green seedlings will produce double flowers. Discard dark green seedlings. After

selection grow on at 10 - 12°C.

pH 6.0 - 6.5

Feeding As flower buds develop keep constantly moist and feed with a well

balanced liquid feed containing trace elements.

Growth regulation Growth regulation may not be necessary. Plants however will respond

to Daminozide at 3.5g/litre.

Pack/Pot size 9 - 10.5cm

Advice 30 - 40% of plants will be double flowered. Grow cool and in bright

light with plenty of ventilation. Good light is essential for the

development of a good flower spike. If plants are to be bedded out they

should be planted out green.

Common diseases Botrytis - Grey Mould and Downy Mildew are both minimised by good

hygiene and adequate ventilation.

Common pests Aphids and Leaf Miner presence should be monitored.
