Culture Information

Rudbeckia Toto

Plant type:

Biennial but treated as an annual

Uses:

Pot plant, bedding and patio containers

Plant height: 20 - 25 cm

Sowing: Sow end February to April for flowering June – August. 18-20°C.

Cover with a thin layer of fine Vermiculite. Germination 1-2 weeks.

Approximate crop timing (mid season)

Sowing to transplanting 6 - 7 weeks to transplanting into final container

Sowing to flowering 13 - 15 weeks Ball 104 to flowering 6 weeks

Growing on:

Temperature 18°C lowering to 16°C when flower stalks begin to elongate.

Minimum night temperature 10°C.

pH 5.8 - 6.2

Watering Plants need a well draining substrate and need to be grown on a fairly

dry regime

Feeding Little feed is needed in the early stages. A balanced NPK fertiliser is

needed as the plant matures and initiates flowers.

Lighting Maintain a 14 – 16-hour day if growing pre-March and natural long day

conditions. Supplementary lighting is beneficial to seedling production

in low light conditions.

Growth regulation The variety Toto is dwarf and does not normally need chemical growth

regulation. Rudbeckia in general are responsive to Daminozide

Pot size 11 - 13cm

Spacing Space the plants in good time to maintain good quality.

Common diseases Pythium. Botrytis especially in humid/poor ventilated conditions.

Common pests Aphids
