Wallflower (Cheiranthus) F1 Sugar Rush

Plant type: Hardy biennial

Uses: Garden border and patio containers

Sugar Rush is happy to be grown along pansies for Autumn and Spring.

Does not require vernalization for flowering.

pH 5.8-6.5

Fertiliser Fertilise 1-3 times per week with a 150-200 ppm N from 15-5-15 and 17-5-

1/.

Keep media EC 1.5-2.0mmhos

Planting out Ideal for autumn colour for patio container use but can also be used for in

garden borders planting at 20cm spacing.

Growth regulation No plant growth regulators are necessary for this crop. Plants will stay

compact and uniform when grown in wet/dry cycles. Growing on the dry side is the best natural growth regulator. However, plants will respond to

Daminozide.

Pack/Pot size 9-13cm Pots

Advice Ensure good ventilation throughout the Winter months. Do not allow the

plants to become waterlogged, keep plants as dry as possible.

Common diseases Botrytis, Xanthomonas and Pythium

Common pests Aphids, Thrip, Flea Beetle and Mites.
