## Wallflower

## (See Culture Focus Sheet W2 for Sunset and W3 for Sugar Rush culture)

**Plant type:** Biennial

**Uses:** Garden border and patio containers

Plant height: 25-35cm

**Sowing:** Sow June – August for March - April flowering.

15°C.

Cover with an average layer of medium Vermiculite.

Germination in 2 - 3 weeks.

Temperatures above 20°C will depress germination.

## Approximate crop timing (mid season)

Sowing to transplanting 3-4 weeks

**Growing on:** 

Temperature Maintain a temperature of  $16 - 18^{\circ}$ C for 1 week after transplanting to

allow roots to establish. Packs can then be grown on in cold frame,

tunnel or outdoor standing out area.

pH 6.0 - 7.0

Feeding Incorporation of long-term slow release fertiliser in the pack can be

useful.

Growth regulation Plants will respond to PGRs. Water plants well and allow the foliage to

dry before spraying. Tom Thumb and Bloomsy Baby varieties are

compact and growth regulation should not be necessary.

Pack/Pot size 6 pack/9–10cm pot, up to 15-19cm for the more vigorous varieties.

Planting out Ideal for container use but can also be used for bedding out planting at

15 – 20cm spacing.

Advice Ensure good ventilation throughout the Winter months.

Do not allow the plants to become waterlogged.

Common diseases Botrytis (Grey Mould), Xanthomonas (Wilt)

Common pests Aphids, Flea Beetle
