The Ball Summer Trials at West Adderbury was the first Professional Trial Grounds in the UK to open its doors to customers this season.

This year's event not only presented numerous leading varieties in baskets, containers and flower beds, but also included extensive Perennial and Annual presentations in 'retail ready' pot displays, something customers really appreciated being able to see.

The extended trialling area of over 2,000 experimental Annual and Perennial varieties provides visitors full transparency on 'Whats cooking in the kitchen', a great insight to the continuous stream of future new plant varieties.

This remarkable colour break sets a new benchmark for what is already considered one of the best programmable Calibrachoa series on the market; Cabaret[®]

Like all colours in the Cabaret[®] series it is closely matched for timing, habit and flower size. The

well-branched, mounded and trailing plants have a full centre, are covered with many flowers on dark green foliage and provides outstanding garden performance in all weathers. At lower temperatures they are less sensitive than most other Calibrachoa. On the nursery Cabaret[®] is proving to be an excellent Calibrachoa choice for performance in peat-free substrates. This variety can be grown in 9-12 cm pots and is one of the earliest flowering Calibrachoa on the market.

Good Night Kiss will make an excellent ingredient for exciting plant combinations or planted in its own right in a hanging basket or patio container. Flowers June to end September. Height and spread 30cm. A real all-round winner for the home gardener!

Available as a 128 and 180 Leg Tray, delivery weeks 6 - 22. A high impact colour Ball label is supplied with the plugs.



Zinnia Zesty Mixed



Zesty's excellent garden vigour, performance in all weathers and well branched plants sets it apart from other Z. elegans, and makes it perfect for planting in the border, patio containers and mixed combinations. Plus, pollinators just love this plant!

Plant height and spread 30-40cm

The Zesty series is supplied as coated seed and as Zesty Mixed in a Ball 104 and 230 Tray weeks 14-18.

An ideal variety to drop into 1 - 2 litre pots for summer colour sales.

Its brightly coloured, large 10cm double flowers really 'pop' and in the garden and are long lasting. The plants have incredible weather resistance and maintain a tidy habit throughout the whole summer season. A great choice for retail and local authority use. Height and spread 20-30cm

Available as pelleted seed and as a Ball 84 Tray, weeks 10-16. Plugs can be dropped straight into retail pots, hanging pots or baskets.

NEW Delphinium hybrida Red Lark

Voted for by visitors as their overall favourite Perennial plant variety



This stunning new Delphinium stopped all our open day visitors in their tracks with its unique coloured flowers.

The striking spikes of coral-red semidouble flowers rise on sturdy stems above an attractive mound of palm shaped foliage. Red Lark is free flowering and produces multiple spikes from June to September from one plant.

In the garden, Red Lark creates quite a focal point. Garden height is approximately 65cm and because of its strong sturdy stems, it needs little or no support. Planted in full sun just intensifies the flower colours. An

excellent choice for home cut flowers and most attractive to

bees and pollinators.

At retail, this new Delphinium will undoubtedly draw shoppers to it like a magnet.

We recommend growing in a 3-5 litre pot. Our Ball 40 plug (available weeks 9 & 11) is ideal for growing in a well ventilated polytunnel allowing plenty of air movement or outside, after the risk of frost has passed.





NEW Rudbeckia hybrida Sunburst Flame



Great autumnal colours for the late summer patio market

Flame is one of the exciting new bold colours in this series of mid-height Rudbeckia for 2022, to provide a burst of rich colours late into the autumn months.

Sunburst Flame and its sister colours (Glow, radiant, Solar and Sunset) have exceptional flowering performance with plants easily holding 40+ large long-lasting 10cm blooms at a time as plants establish. The flower colours interestingly evolve and deepen as the plants mature from mid to late season.

The flowers on Sunburst Flame have a most attractive rich mahogany colouring with a bold outer ring of copper.

This series is perfectly timed to kick in for retail colour sales promotions in July, just when gardeners are looking to refresh some

of their early summer flowering patios and garden plants. Plants will continue to provide garden

colour well into October. Highly attractive to bees and butterflies. Prefers a moist well-drained soil in full sun or partial shade. Semi-hardy: should overwinter if plants are not waterlogged. Garden height and spread 30-40cm.

Available as a Ball 84 paper plug weeks 11 and 15. Planting into a 5-litre pot is recommended under a well ventilated polytunnel or outside (if the risk of frost has passed). No pinching is required for Sunburst as the plants are naturally well branched. The secret to success is to allow plants enough space and provide feed to keep the foliage green and healthy.





NEW Rudbeckia hybrida Sunbeckia® Ophelia (P)



Amazing vigour and ease of growing

Having stolen the show at our 2020 Summer Showcase, it wasn't a surprise to see Sunbeckia[®] in the top varieties list again this year!

This year the new Ophelia (AGM) with its brilliant lime green eyes, surrounded by wide golden petals was the colour that got the most amount of attention.

Gardeners will be amazed by the size of the Sunbeckia® flowers and ease of growing the plants. This variety of Rudbeckia is easily recognisable by its huge 15cm sized flowers and amazing vigour.

The thick flower petals are extremely long lasting and the strong flower stems provide a strong plant with superb garden performance.

Ideal for pots, containers, beds and borders.

Attractive to bees and butterflies. Prefers a moist well-drained soil in full sun or partial shade. Height and spread 40-50cm.

What is truly been outstanding about this variety is that just one plug planted in May will fill a 23cm container by July and produce over 50+ flowers in one season! Available from Ball Colegrave as a Ball 40 plug, delivery weeks 18 & 20. All plugs are ready-pinched and 'breaking'... perfect to simply pot into 5-10 litre pots and sell in as little as 6-8 weeks or, bump-up into much larger patio tubs to maximise retail sales opportunities right into autumn. No pinching is required. The secret to success is to allow plants enough space and provide feed to keep the foliage green and healthy.

Traditionally the Trial Grounds were attended by Parks and Nurserymen. Today they are joined by an everincreasing number of Retail Plant Buyers looking for new plant and retail solutions.
